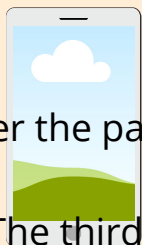


YOUNG VOICES AT THE O2 IN LONDON

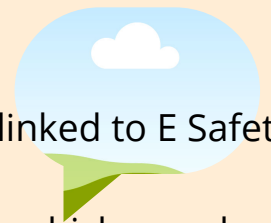

E-SAFETY: CONDUCT



Over the past couple of weeks, we have been looking at the 4Cs linked to E Safety and Safeguarding.

The third category in the 4Cs is Conduct. Conduct is the way in which people behave online. It could be online bullying, how children speak to others in a game or on a social network or app (eg. Whatsapp) or comments left on a YouTube/ Tik Tok video. It could be the photographs and videos they share, or who they are talking to and 'friending'.

Specifically, conduct refers to children's own behaviour online.

Supporting children with ADHD at home continued.

When supporting learning at home think about a multisensory approach. For example:

Hands-on activities: incorporate hands-on activities related to the subject matter.

Multisensory tools: use educational tools that engage different senses, such as interactive apps or manipulatives.

Encourage self-monitoring through self reflection. Teach the children to recognise signs of distractions and restlessness.

We will be letting you know more closer to the time but probably best to be planning a World Book Day costume now!



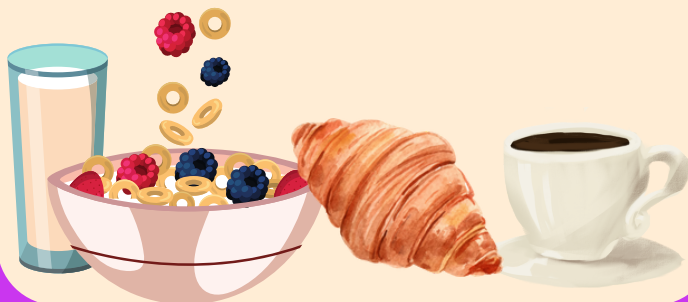

We look forward to seeing you there.

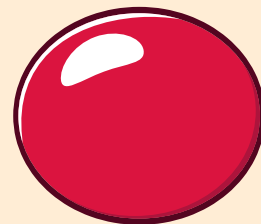


Red Nose Day
