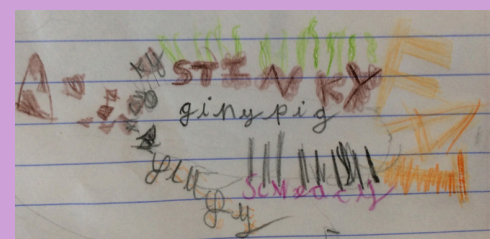
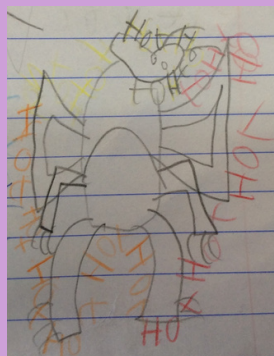
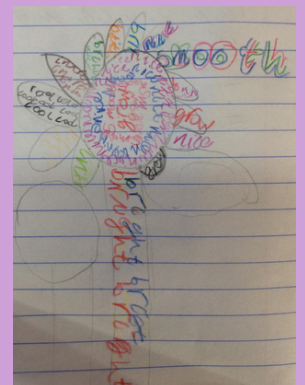
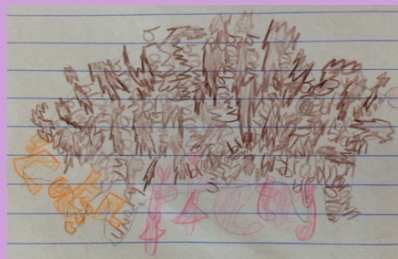
CLASSROOM NEWS




Year 2 have been working on calligrams.
