A Simple Guide to the Types of ADHD for Parents

Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) is a neurodevelopmental condition that affects attention, impulse control, and activity levels. There are three main types of ADHD, and understanding them can help parents support their child effectively.

1. Inattentive Type

Children with this type of ADHD primarily struggle with focus and organization but are not overly active or impulsive.

2. Hyperactive-Impulsive Type

This type is marked by excessive energy, restlessness, and impulsive actions.

3. Combined Type

This is the most common type, where children show both inattentive and hyperactive-impulsive traits.
